

Article 23:
The demand of security, peace, rights & justice, require all states to consider Zionism an illegitimate movement, to outlaw its existence, to ban its operations, [& to reject normalization with the "Israeli"/Zionist entity].

Article 21:
The Arab Palestinian people, expressing themselves by the armed Palestinian revolution, reject all solutions which are substitutes for the total liberation of Palestine & reject all proposals aiming at the liquidation of the Palestinian problem, or its internationalization.

Article 15:
Absolute responsibility [media, military, political] for [the liberation of Palestine] falls upon [the free nations of the world] - peoples and governments - with the Arab people of Palestine in the vanguard. It must enable them to carry out their leading role, in the armed revolution, until they liberate their homeland.

Article 30:
Fighters and carriers of arms in the war of liberation are the nucleus of the popular army which will be the protective force for the gains of the Palestinian Arab people.

Article 9:
Armed struggle is the only way to liberate Palestine [and is] the overall strategy, not merely a tactical phase.

The Palestinian Arab people assert their absolute determination and firm resolution to continue their armed struggle, to work for an armed popular revolution for the liberation of their country and their return to it... & to exercise their right to self-determination and sovereignty

Article 1 & 2:
Palestine is the homeland of the Arab Palestinian people - with the boundaries it had during the British Mandate [as] an indivisible territorial unit. [with Al-Quds as the capital of Palestine]

Article 3:
The Palestinian Arab people possess the legal right to their homeland and have the right to determine their destiny after achieving the liberation of their country

Resolutions of the Palestine National Council (July 17, 1968)
